STATUS OF PTC ACCREDITATION



- Started first accreditation activities in 2012
- Mentored by Engineers Australia 3 mentoring visits & observation of accreditation reviews
- Nomination visits by IEET and EA
- Review visits conducted by IES and IEM (under FEIAP)
- Program Accreditation Status
 - 4 Programs 2nd cycle of accreditation completed
 - 44 Programs 2nd cycle of accreditation in the next few months
 - 30 Programs interim review for full accreditation in the next few months
 - 11 Programs final review and decision making ongoing
- Issued 2nd Edition of Accreditation Criteria and Guidelines in 2019
- Deferred Request for Initial Evaluation of Programs (for first time accreditation with PTC-ACBET) until AY2021-2022 because of pandemic
