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

Background





Prior to 2002: Engineering programs were accredited by overseas accrediting bodies such as the engineering institutions of EC UK and ABET

EAB comprises 20 members of various engineering background

- IES members, non-government organizations, industry and business community;
- the Professional Engineers Board, Singapore;
- Universities with engineering programmes.

EAB's Accreditation system



- Benchmarked to meet requirements of Washington Accord
- Academic programs should be equivalent to a 4-year full-time course
- Evaluation process comprises (a) Self Assessment Report (SAR) and (b) Campus Visit
 - Assessment of each program is based on the following 11 accreditation criteria:

CRITERION 1	 MISSION AND PROGRAMME EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES
CRITERION 2	– STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES
CRITERION 3	– CURRICULUM AND TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESSES
CRITERION 4	- STUDENTS
CRITERION 5	– FACULTY MEMBERS
CRITERION 6	– FACILITIES AND LEARNING ENVIRONMENT
CRITERION 7	– INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT AND FINANCIAL RESOURCES
CRITERION 8	 GOVERNANCE AND CONTINUOUS QUALITY IMPROVEMENT
CRITERION 9	 INTERACTION BETWEEN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION AND INDUSTRY
CRITERION 10	– RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT
CRITERION 11	– SPECIFIC PROGRAMME CRITERIA

The Self Assessment Report (SAR) will need to address the above criteria

Evaluation Team



Each Evaluation Team (3) will normally comprise:

- One international member (usually from a WA signatory) Team Chair
- At least one from industry
- An academic


Accreditation Visits:
